

Industry Snapshot

The largest sector in Will County, Illinois is Transportation and Warehousing, employing 37,908 workers. The next-largest sectors in the region are Retail Trade (31,543 workers) and Health Care and Social Assistance (26,866). High location quotients (LQs) indicate sectors in which a region has high concentrations of employment compared to the national average. The sectors with the largest LQs in the region are Transportation and Warehousing (LQ = 2.84), Wholesale Trade (1.69), and Other Services (except Public Administration) (1.28).

Employment data are derived from the Quarterly Census of Employment and Wages, provided by the Bureau of Labor Statistics and imputed where necessary. Data are updated through 2021Q3 with preliminary estimates updated to 2021Q4.

Sectors in Will County, Illinois with the highest average wages per worker are Utilities (\$147,589), Wholesale Trade (\$99,063), and Management of Companies and Enterprises (\$98,806). Regional sectors with the best job growth (or most moderate job losses) over the last 5 years are Transportation and Warehousing (+18,459 jobs), Other Services (except Public Administration) (+1,597), and Manufacturing (+870).

Over the next 1 year, employment in Will County, Illinois is projected to expand by 2,487 jobs. The fastest growing sector in the region is expected to be Arts, Entertainment, and Recreation with a +3.2% year-over-year rate of growth. The strongest forecast by number of jobs over this period is expected for Accommodation and Food Services (+485 jobs), Health Care and Social Assistance (+443), and Transportation and Warehousing (+367).

Gross Domestic Product


Gross Domestic Product (GDP) is the total value of goods and services produced by a region. In 2020, nominal GDP in Will County, Illinois contracted 1.8%. This follows growth of 2.5% in 2019. As of 2020, total GDP in Will County, Illinois was \$29,407,926,000.

Of the sectors in Will County, Illinois, Manufacturing contributed the largest portion of GDP in 2020, \$4,637,073,000 The next-largest contributions came from Wholesale Trade (\$3,313,069,000); Transportation and Warehousing (\$2,719,388,000); and Real Estate and Rental and Leasing (\$2,506,248,000).
